

Black Rhino

The pages of this pack give some general information about black rhinos and some fun and engaging activities to foster and develop children's interest in them.

This pack includes:

- **Fact posters x3** (Could be used as stimuli for a lesson input)

grasses and **leaves**.

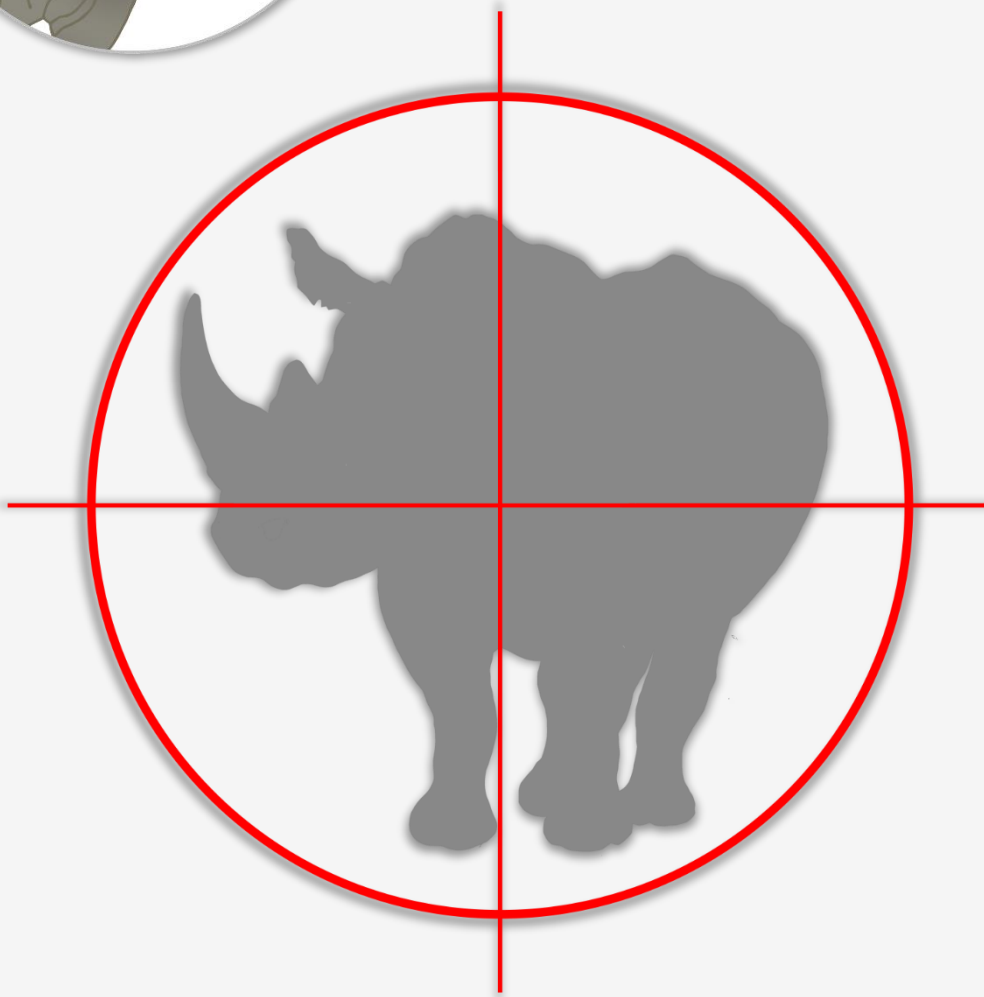


Rhinos have been on Earth for 50 million years!



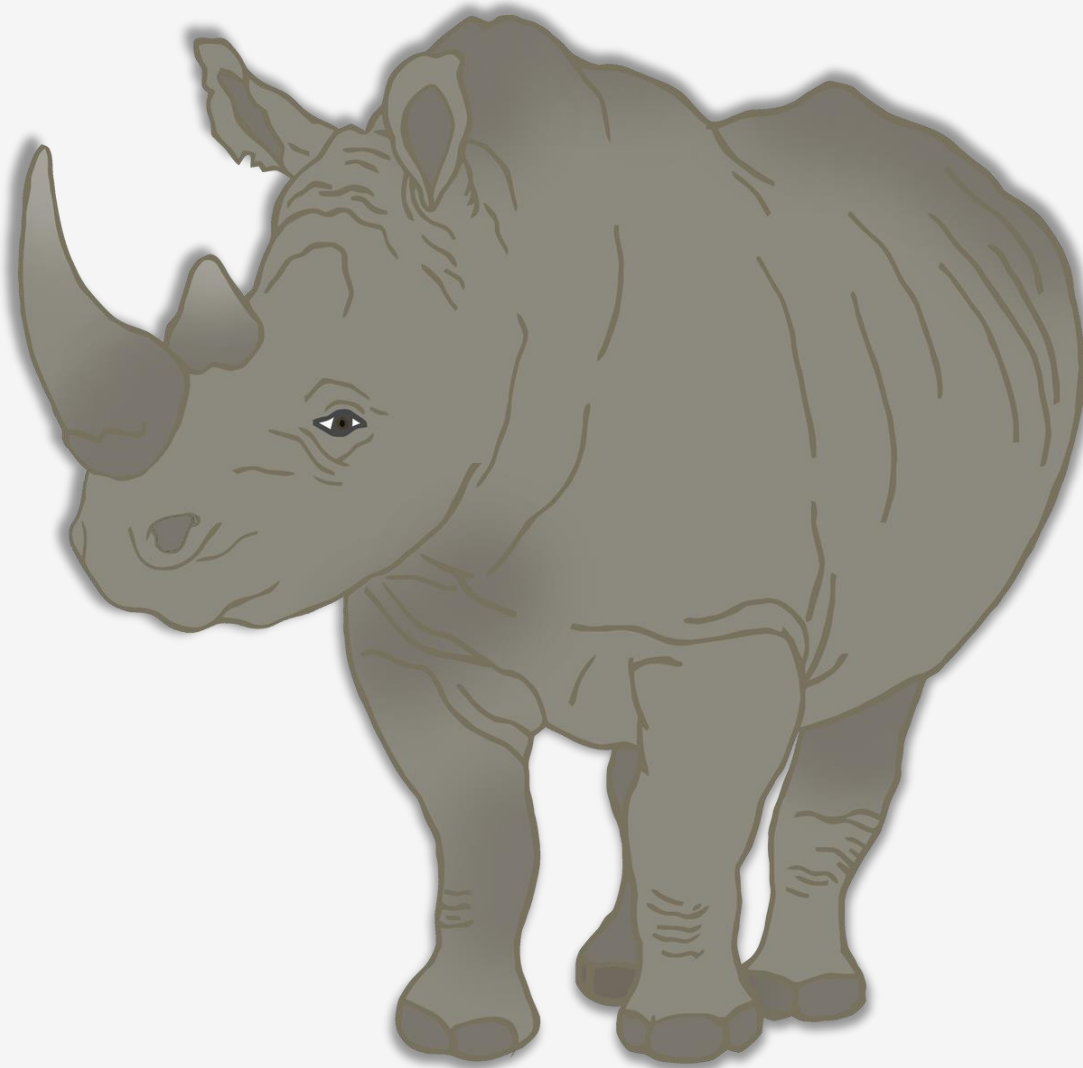
Black Rhinos are **Endangered**.

This means there is a very high risk that they may become extinct.

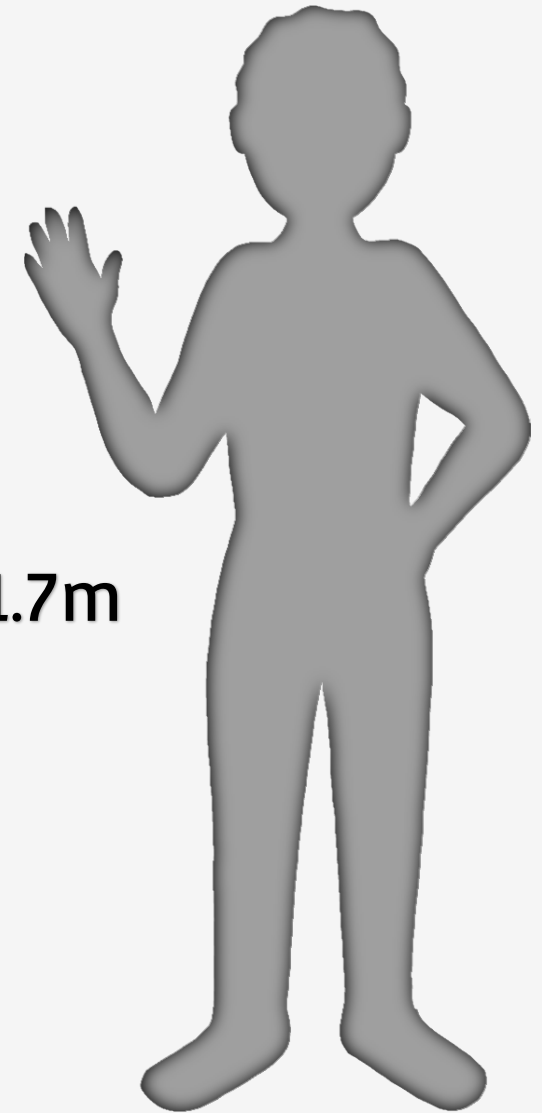


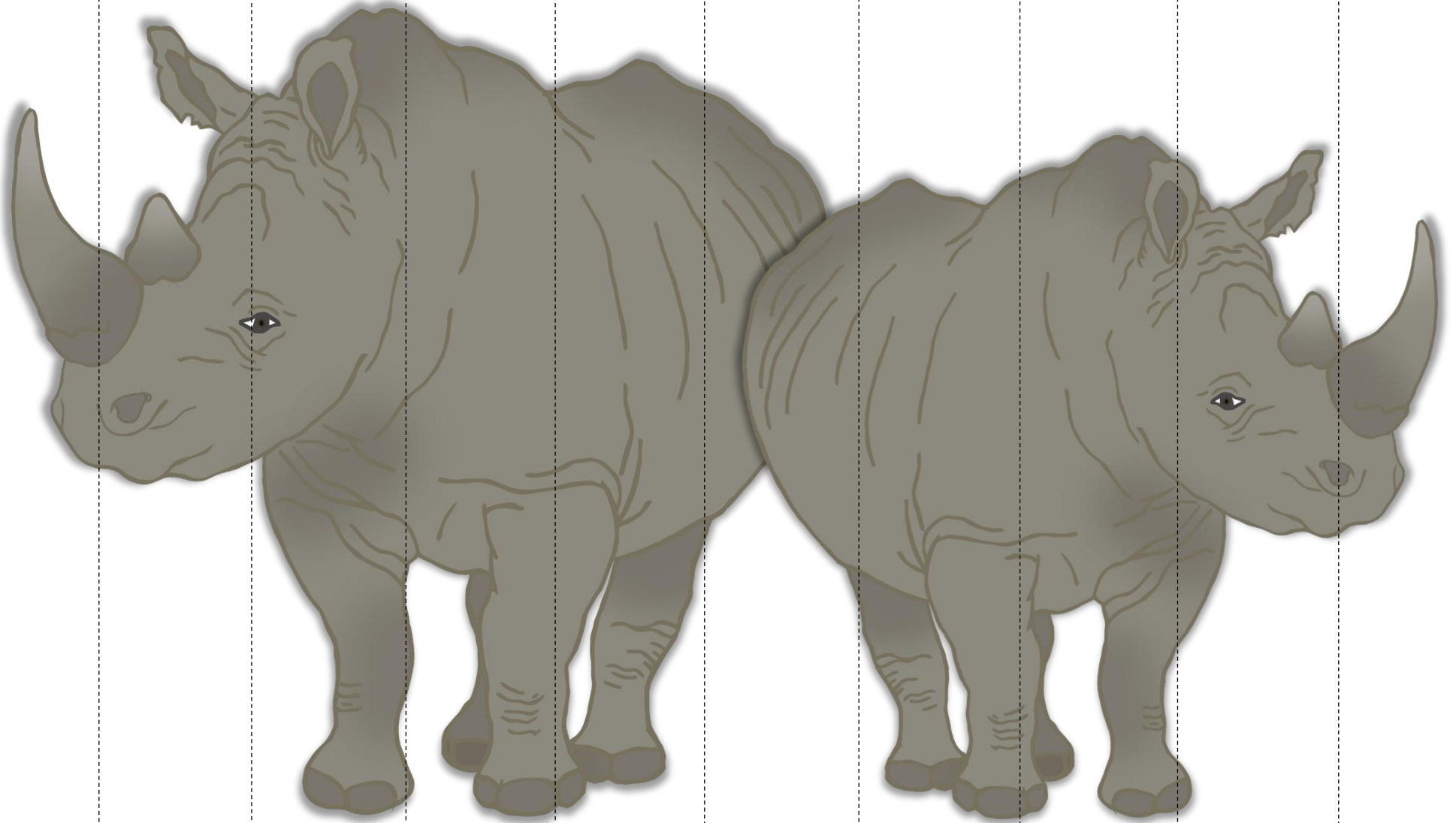
Humans have hunted and killed many black rhinos.

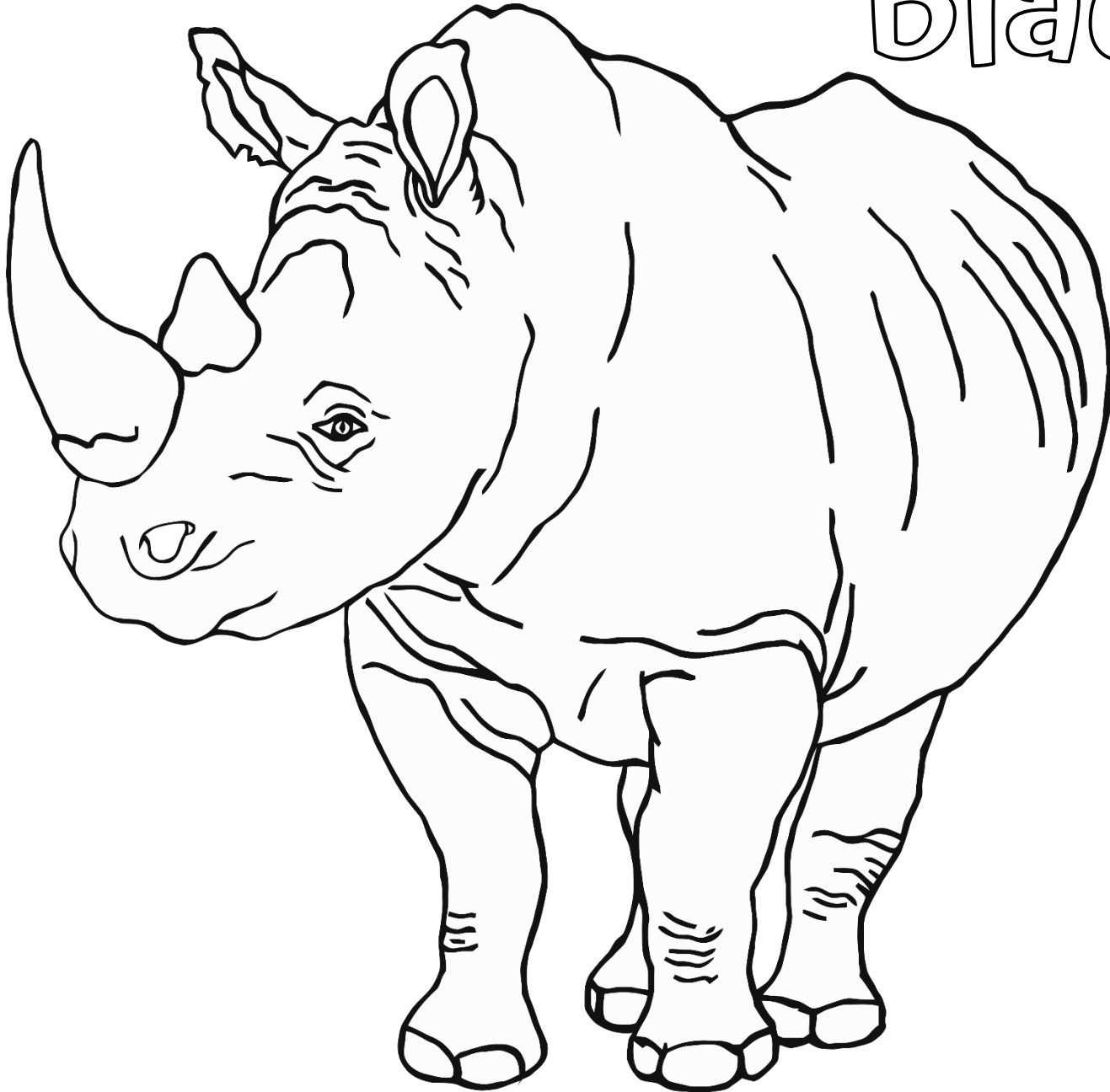

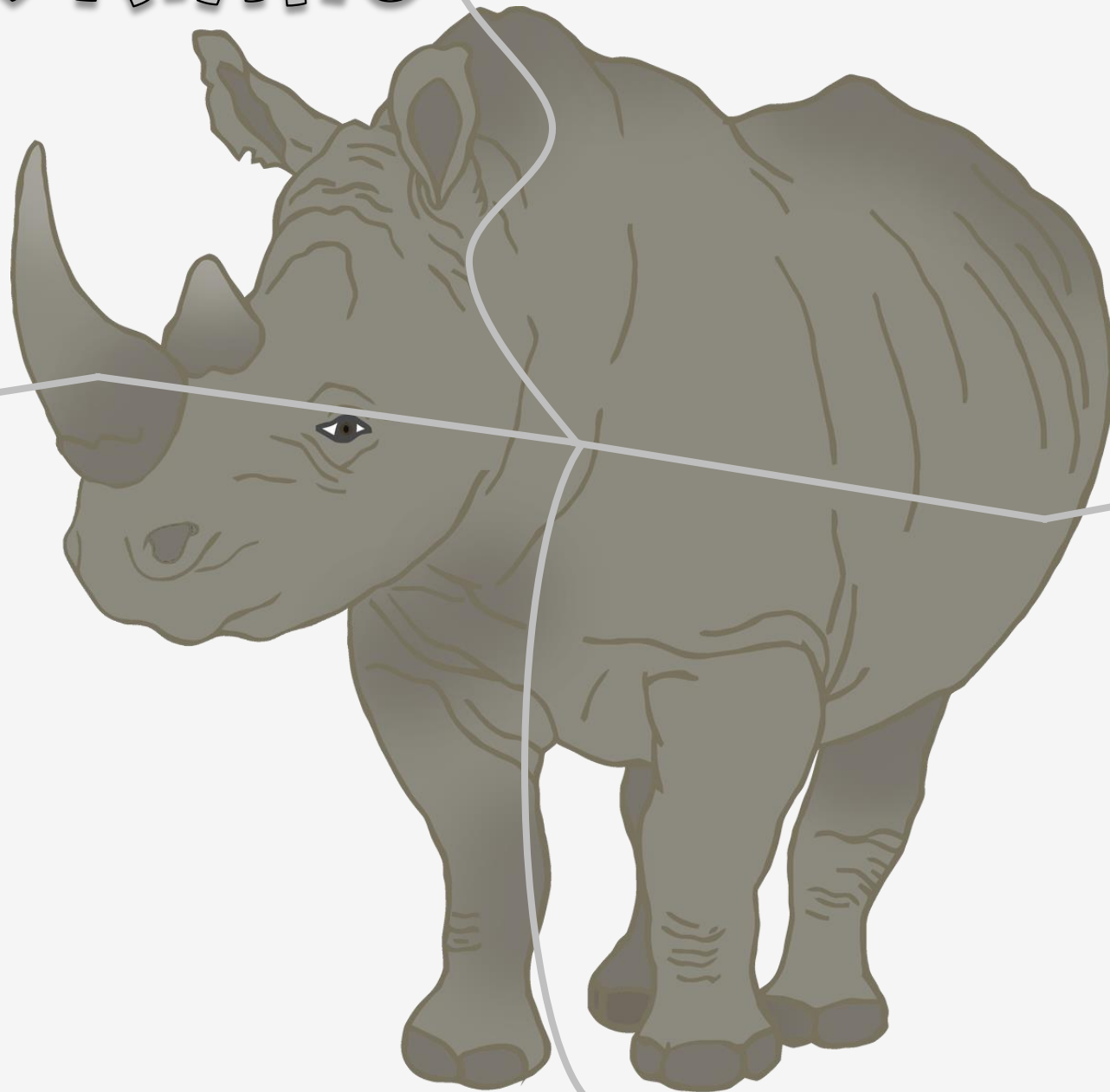

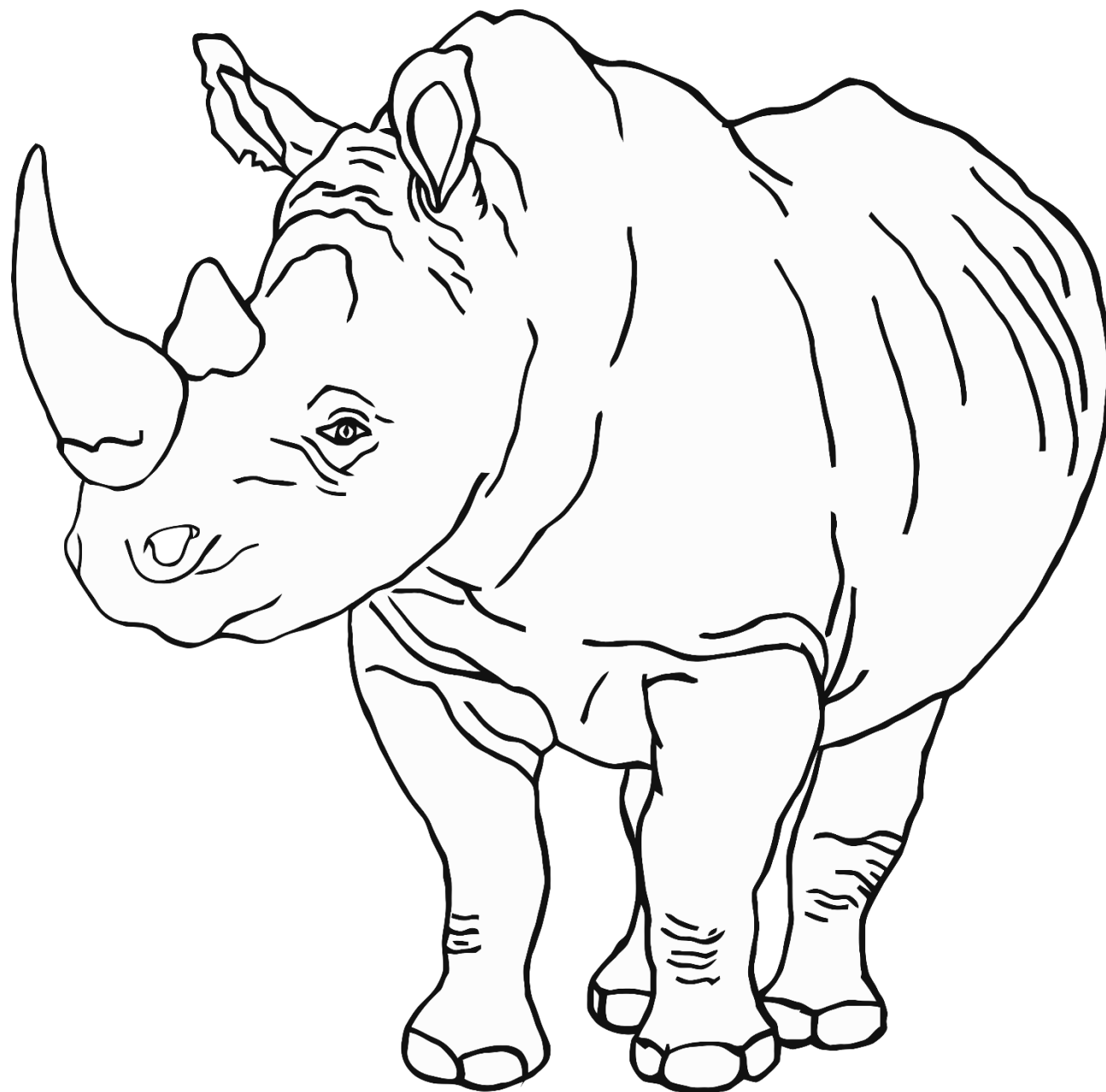

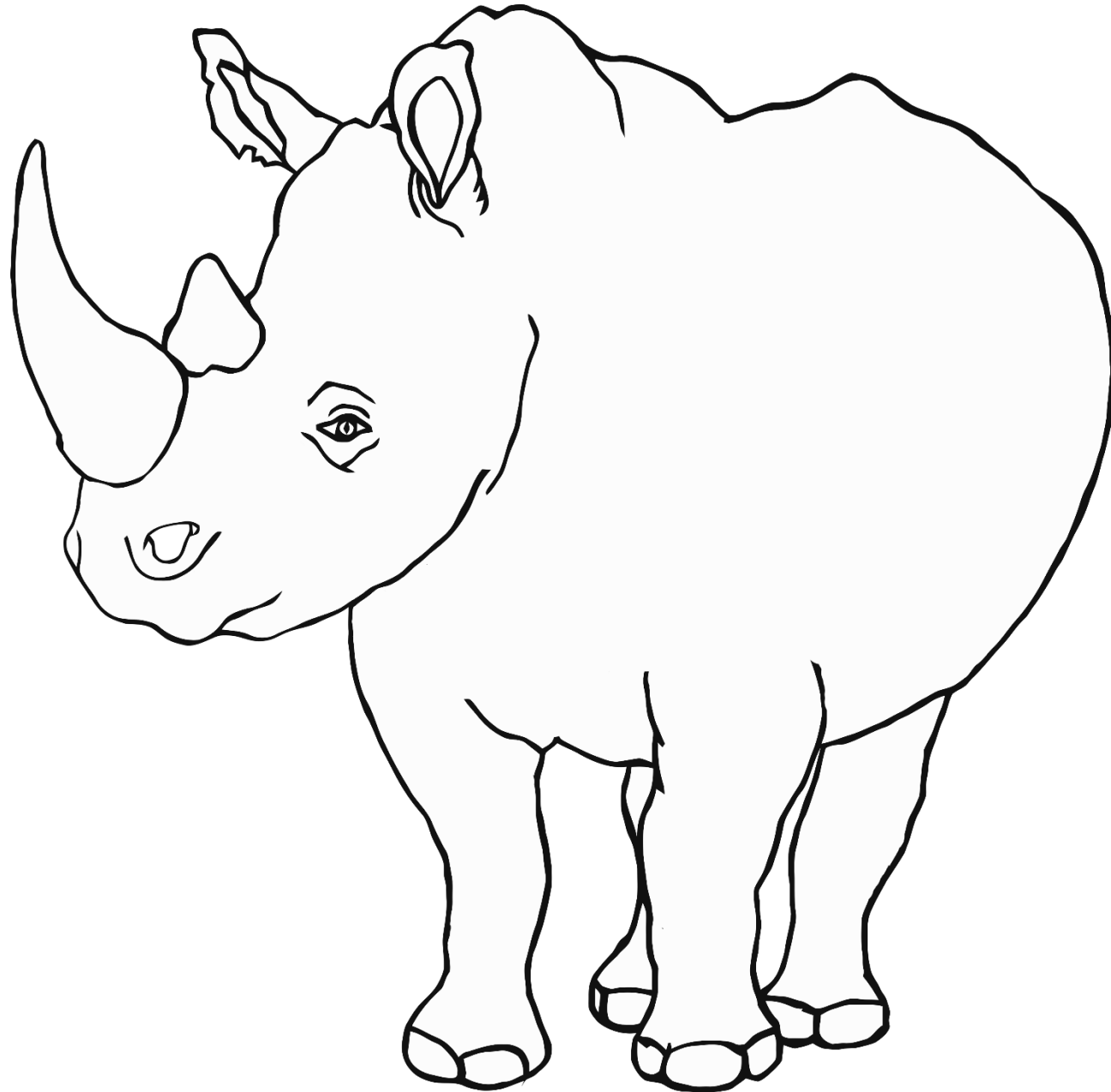

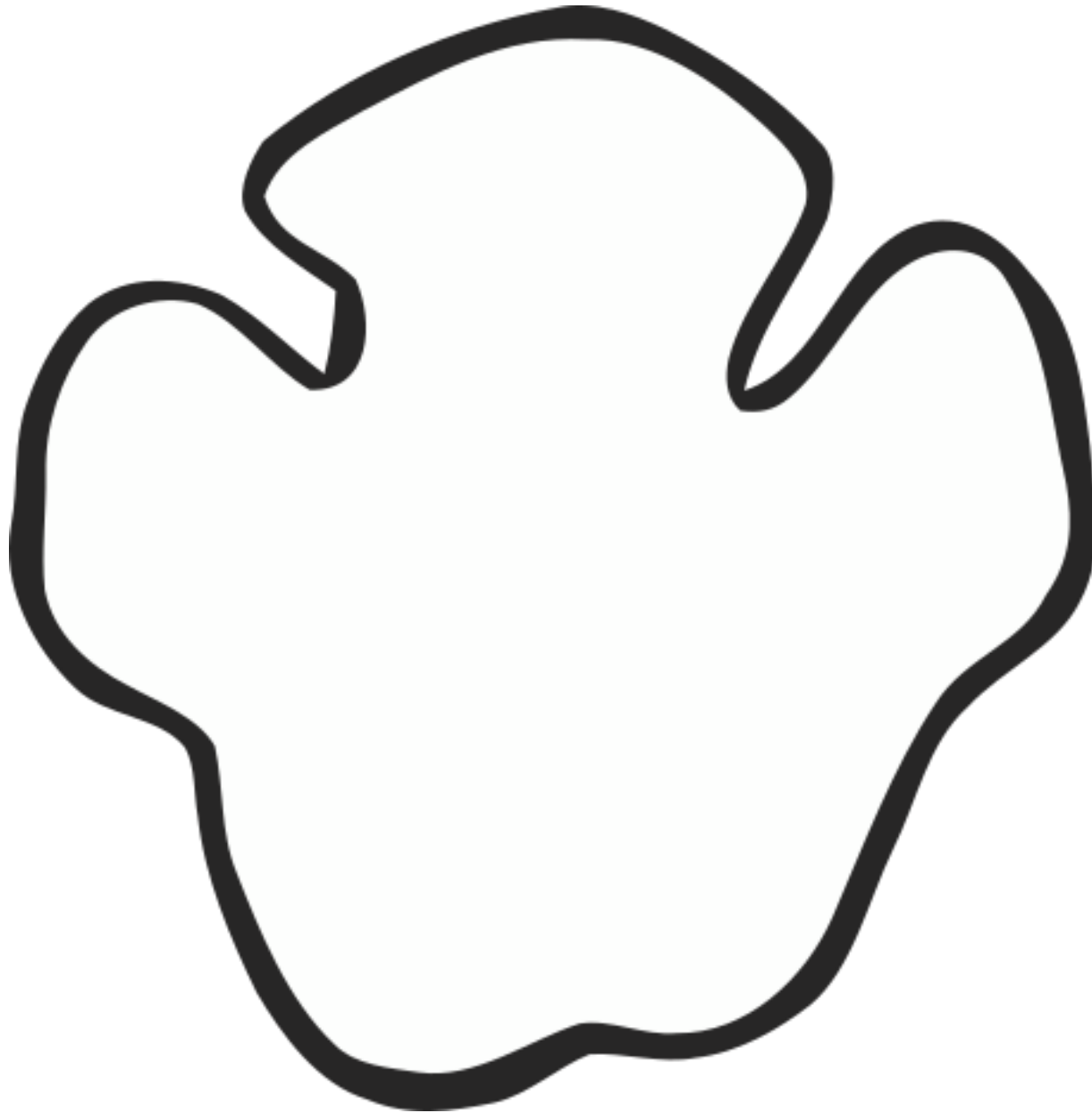
Black Rhino Multimat – Rhino (1)
