
Character Description Sheets (col) – The Enormous Turnip




At the end of the pack is a short question idea card to get the discussion started but add as many other questions as you like and encourage the children to ask their own questions too!

The discussions and ideas are the most important part of this activity!




Character Description - The Enormous Turnip - man




Character Description - The Enormous Turnip - woman



Character Description - The Enormous Turnip - girl




Character Description – The Enormous Turnip – boy
