

Cow




- Eats hay and grain.

Horse




- Eats hay and grass.

Donkey




- Eats hay, grass and straw.

Pig




- Eats corn or soybean meal.

Dog




- Eats meat.

Sheep




- Eats grass and clover.

Goose




- Eats grass and green vegetables.
