## Subitising <br> Hedgehogs (5-10)



These hedgehogs have random collections of 5-10 dots on them. The children are to be asked to sort them to the correct number pile. At first, they may do this by counting the dots $1: 1$ but should be encouraged to try and instantly see how many dots are there in small groups to help them find the total.

## For example:

"That's two dots isn't it?...And here are three dots. We don't need to count them we already know!"
