


Rabbits' teeth never stop growing!

Many people call a baby rabbit a bunny, but its proper name is a kitten.




Rabbits are very social animals. They feel most safe and secure when around other rabbits.





Rabbits can be easily frightened by loud noises and sudden movements. In fact, big shocks can be very bad for their health.
