


The pages of this pack give some general information about green sea turtles and some fun and engaging activities to foster and develop children's interest in them.

- Multimats x2 (for Colouring/Art & Craft/Loose Parts/Playdough)







Sea Turtles are Endangered.


This means there is a very high risk that they may become extinct.







Sea turtles think that plastic bags left in the sea are food. The bags are very bad for them. Humans have hunted and killed many sea turtles.











