These writing prompts will help encourage mark-making and writing after the children have been on a winter walk with all the interesting sights and sounds that entails.


The sheets cover an ability range from first mark-making up to full sentence writing.

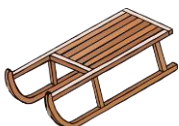

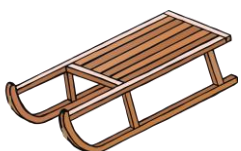
Later sheets encourage writing using blending and offer some scaffolding towards greater difficulty and independence.

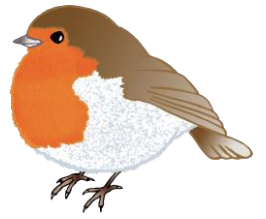

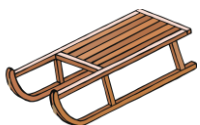
