


Woodland Wildlife Draw & Write

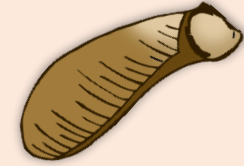
